Why do we need your help?

St Peter's Hospice is the only adult hospice that provides care for patients with life limiting illness across South Gloucestershire, Bristol and North Somerset, an area of nearly 1 million people. Last year, we cared for 2,200 patients and supported more than 6,000 family members.

At St Peter's Hospice, we believe that everyone should have the support they need when faced with a terminal illness. We want to help our patients and their families maintain as high a quality of life as possible. We want them to continue to feel informed, supported, and cared for.

Our Day Hospice looks after up to 20 patients each day. This gives patients the opportunity to be assessed by skilled nurses and a doctor, but equally as important is the opportunity to be with other people facing similar challenges. This peer support is immeasurable.

From crafts sessions and music therapy, to massage and tennis on the Nintendo Wii, the range of activities Day Hospice offers means we can really make a patient's day with us a positive and therapeutic one. Group activities, such as relaxation, gentle exercise sessions and making nutritional smoothies, develop skills that can continue at home.



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We are asking for your support to help us improve our Day Hospice so we can provide even better care for our patients.

A purpose built kitchen – helping patients stay independent for as long as possible is crucial. A new kitchen in Day Hospice will mean patients can practice and get comfortable with using any specialist equipment.

Improved resources – to talk about nutrition and the importance of food and diet on our health.

New and varied activities – we look after all adults from their early 20s to late 90s and we would like to have activities that appeal across this age range.

Raised flower beds – simple things like raising flower beds so our patients can do some gentle gardening, and smell and see the plants more easily, will have a big impact on their well being.

Increased availability of beauty therapies – we all feel better when we've been a little pampered. Illness can have a big effect on a patient's hair, nails and general wellbeing making them self conscious about going to their usual salons. We would like to offer more continued access to therapies in a safe environment to help all our patients feel better.
