# About our work

## **St Peter's Hospice is Bristol's only adult Hospice.**

We aim to improve the quality of life for all our patients and provide them with the best possible care.

We provide help and support to people with life limiting illnesses and their families in many ways. All of our services are provided free of charge to our patients and their families.

## **In the community**

Through our team of 18 community nurse specialists we provide care across the whole of Bristol in patient's own homes. For most patients these nurses are the first point of contact from St Peter's Hospice. They make regular visits to patients, offering support and comfort throughout their illness. Each year our nurses provide support to over 1,800 patients.



## **Hospice at Home**

Our Hospice at Home nurses provide specialist 24 hour care to patients who wish to spend the last few weeks or days of their life in their own home. We have a team of 19 nurses working across the greater Bristol area providing care and support in those vital last days.





## **Day Hospice**

Our Day Hospice looks after up to 20 patients each day. It gives patients the opportunity to be assessed by skilled nurses and a doctor, but equally important is the

opportunity to be with other people facing similar challenges. Patients can be referred to a complementary therapist, music therapy and participate in discussion groups. Our therapeutic programme involves group relaxation and gentle exercise each day. The day is full, but gently paced to meet each patients needs.

## **Inpatient Unit**

Our Inpatient Unit provides patients with expert medical care by senior specialist doctors where a patient's difficult symptoms can be brought under control. We also have a family room at the Hospice where family members can stay overnight to be close to their loved one.

## **Education centre**

As well as the work that our nursing team do with patients and families we also have a well respected education centre with trainers who work with those who advise and care for patients away from St Peter's Hospice such as GPs and care home workers.

## **Social Work and Chaplaincy**

Through our Social Work team and Chaplaincy we work with over 6,000 family members over a year providing emotional, spiritual and practical help during a difficult time to families including children.
