About St Peter's Hospice

St Peter's Hospice is Bristol's only adult hospice, caring for people with incurable illnesses and their families. We provide a range of specialist services enabling our patients to have the very best quality of life possible in the time they have left.

All our services are free of charge but cost St Peter's Hospice over £6 million a year to provide. With only a small proportion of the funds we need coming from the NHS, we rely heavily on the support of the local community.

Our care is so special because of the time and attention we are able to give. This can make an enormous difference to the whole family in the last few months, weeks and days of someone's life. Such specialist care is expensive to provide and with more people needing our help every year we need ongoing support to ensure people can have this care in the future.



Your donations will be spent locally, benefiting local people. By setting up a direct debit you will reduce our administration costs and help us to reach even more people who need our care every year.

- **£2 a month could help towards our Hospice at Home service which provides specialist care to patients who wish to spend their last week of life at home.**
- **£5 a month could pay for important equipment that we need to administer continuous medication and keep patients comfortable.**
