



About St Peter's Hospice

St Peter's Hospice is Bristol's hospice. We care for people with incurable illnesses, usually cancer, and provide support to their families.

Our specialist palliative care is provided at our two hospices and across Bristol, by our Community Nurse Specialists and Hospice at Home teams.

All our patient services are free.

Our professional care and support teams are all specialists in their own field. Together we provide an integrated holistic approach to caring for patients' needs.

St Peter's Hospice believes

that all treatments offered to patients should be appropriate for that individual patient, who can then make choices according to their own priorities.

The care and treatments offered by the hospice will always aim to treat all aspects of the whole person: **physical, social, psychological and spiritual.**

Our **Community Nurse Specialists** work in three geographical teams across Greater Bristol.

Each nurse has considerable experience, with additional specialist training and qualifications in palliative care. Our nurse specialists will visit patients at home and will spend time reviewing their personal situation. Other members of the hospice team, such as doctors and social workers, work with these specialist nurses to help them and the primary health care teams to achieve as much as possible for all patients.

The Day Hospices based at Knowle and Brentry, offer a structured day for patients, who normally attend for one day each week. Our aim is to provide professional advice and practical help to enable the patient to lead as full and independent a life as possible.

We have **In-patient units** at our Brentry and Knowle hospices where patients can be admitted for a period so that difficult symptoms can be brought under control. Alternatively a patient may be admitted for short periods to provide respite

for the family. Patients also come to the unit for the last days of their illness, should this be what they, their family and their own doctor wish.



Our **Hospice at Home** service provides 24 hour nursing support to patients and their carers at home during the last week of life. The aim of this limited service is to allow patients to choose to die in their own home when admission to hospital or hospice might otherwise be needed.
