### How you can help

#### Making a donation

All donations are very much appreciated by everyone at St Peter's Hospice. Donations can be made by cash, cheque (made payable to 'St Peter's Hospice') or credit card and should be sent to: St Peter's Hospice Fundraising Office, 58 Royal York Crescent, Clifton, Bristol, BS8 4JP. You will receive a letter of thanks acknowledging your kind donation.

#### Gift Aid

If you are a UK tax-payer we can claim an extra 28% of the value of your donation from the government at no extra cost to you. Please complete the relevant section of this form to enable us to claim this extra funding from the government.



#### Donations at a funeral

We can help by providing you with donation envelopes for family and friends to make donations. They can also gift aid their donations (see previous page for details).

#### Donations in lieu of flowers

We keep a record of all the donations received in memory of your loved one, whether they are sent directly or via your funeral director. Any donations received directly are acknowledged on receipt and after 8 weeks we will write to the next of kin with a summary of donations made. The majority of donations will have been received by this time.

#### Remembrance Funds

We have recently introduced Remembrance Funds as a very special way of remembering someone special. They serve as a lasting and personal memorial to your loved one and can act as a positive focus for the future, helping us continue to care for local people. Whether your loved one was cared for by St Peter's Hospice or if you just want to remember someone special to you by supporting your local hospice, it is a simple way to enable family and friends to contribute in whatever way they want.
