Thank you for your enquiry about our Will Fortnight Campaign, which runs from 8 – 21 October 2018.

A group of amazing solicitors are giving you their time, free of charge and will draft or update a **standard** Will for you. In return, all we ask is that you make a donation to St Peter's Hospice. To give you some idea of how much this would normally cost you, solicitors usually charge upward of £175 to draft a standard Will.

Some of our solicitors will allocate a certain amount of time for bookings to be made on a first come first served basis.

Within this pack you will find

- a list of the participating firms and solicitors
- a Will Planner to complete before your appointment
- a donation form

It is very easy to take part. You simply:

- Select a solicitor from the list
- Phone and make a convenient appointment – **please make sure you mention the St Peter's Hospice Make a Will Fortnight campaign when making the appointment**
- Complete the enclosed initial contact sheet and the information sheet prior to your appointment and take with you

At the end of your appointment(s), you can leave your donation with your solicitor who will forward it on to us. Simply complete the donation form and give it, along with your donation in an envelope marked 'private and confidential', to your solicitor. We are asking people to consider a donation of between £150 and £200 but the amount you donate is entirely up to you.

St Peter's Hospice cared for more than 2,000 local people with life-limiting illnesses last year and also provided support to their families. The money raised through this campaign will help us to continue providing our services to those who desperately need them.
