# About our work

St Peter's Hospice is Bristol's only adult Hospice. We aim to improve the quality of life for all our patients and provide them with the best possible care.

We provide care and support for patients with life-limiting illnesses and their families and carers. All of our services are provided free of charge to our patients and their families but it costs us around £19,000 a day to provide this care. For most of this money we rely on Gifts in Wills, donations, fundraising and our shops.

## In the community

We work in the community to care for patients in any setting wherever they are living.

Our Community Nurse Specialists are experienced nurses with additional training in palliative care and communication skills. We have four teams of Community Nurse Specialists which work from different localities so that they are near to where people live. They work alongside GPs and other community nurses in their area and meet them regularly to discuss patients' symptom management, support and care. They also work with hospital teams.

## Hospice at Home

Our Hospice at Home service provides short-term hands-on nursing care for patients in their own homes. This care is provided by Registered Nurses and Health Care Assistants who are trained and experienced in the care of the dying and their families.



## Day Hospice

Day Services aims to provide a therapeutic environment that increases patients' sense of confidence and empowerment in living with their illnesses. If patients are referred to Day Services they go one day a week for 12 weeks. There they can see a range of specialist staff and take part in informal discussion groups, gentle exercise or learn relaxation techniques.

## Inpatient Unit

Our Inpatient Unit has 18 beds for short stays of around two weeks. Our professional team works together to provide palliative care and support for patients who need more intensive help. We also have a family room at the Hospice where family members can stay overnight to be close to their loved one.

## Education Centre

As well as the work that our nursing team does with patients and families, we have a well-respected Education Centre. Our teachers work with those who advise and care for patients away from St Peter's Hospice such as GPs and care home workers.

## Patient and Family Support

Patient and family support is provided by a small group of services that collectively support individuals and families who may be struggling to cope with the challenges of serious illness. We offer support on a one-to-one basis, with families or in groups.


